Presenting at NMAS Research Symposium

Abstract submissions for oral and/or poster presentations are **due by midnight on October 6, 2019**. Presenters will be **notified by October 11** of acceptance/non-acceptance. All accepted abstracts will be published in the *2019 New Mexico Journal of Science*.

Abstract Format

Your abstract should contain the following elements:

- Abstract Title
- Author First and Last Name, Author Institution
- Co-author First and Last Name, Institution (add co-authors as applicable) optional
- Body of the Abstract: General topic statement; Problem addressed; Summary of state of the field; Research methods; Results; Implication/impact
- Keywords (up to five)

Guidelines for Abstract Submission

- 1. Abstracts must be uploaded during registration as a Word file (.doc or .docx). The title of the abstract file **must** contain the lead author's last name.
- 2. Abstracts are limited to 300 words.
- 3. By submitting an abstract, you are granting NMAS and NM EPSCoR permission to publish it in the abstract compilation and to disseminate it electronically.
- 4. Please ensure that you submit an abstract for the correct session type (oral, poster, or both).

ORAL Presentations

- Oral presentation are presented using visual presentation software, e.g., PowerPoint or Google Slides.
- Each oral presentation is allotted 20 minutes including questions.
- Computers and digital projectors are provided.
- Oral presentation session times: Session I (9:00 am to 10:30 am); Session II (10:50 am to 12:20 pm).

POSTER Presentations

- Presenters are expected to print their own posters.
- Posters must be 48" x 36".
- All student posters will be judged for an opportunity to win prizes!
- Poster session is 2:00 to 3:30 pm; presenters must be present.
